BNT 111 Gospel of John Part I

The Gospel of John shows Jesus as the “Son of God.” Let His example of love and compassion be your measuring stick, as you study His faith working by love. Learn of this perfect love and then go into the world doing “greater works” for the kingdom of God. The miracle at the wedding feast, telling Nicodemus you must be born again, feeding the 5000, the Good Shepherd, and the raising of Lazarus are just a few of the things studied in this class. You will have a closer relationship with Jesus after taking this course.

BOT 109 The Book of Joshua

This course begins with the Lord saying to Joshua, “Moses, my servant is dead; now arise and go over the Jordan into the land I have given you. No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you and I will not fail you nor forsake you. Therefore be strong and courageous.” It seems today’s culture encourages weakness, not strength. Yet, God’s people are called to fight for His kingdom, pursue our purpose in Christ, and take hold of all God has in store for us.

BOT 114 The Study of I & II Samuel

Samuel was God’s bridge builder. He was the last judge and the first of the prophets after Moses. As Judge and Prophet, God used him as a great spiritual leader to the tribes of Israel in a time when they were in desperate need for direction. We will be studying the life of Samuel and the characteristics of a prophet. He anointed Saul the first king and then David his successor. We will discover David’s secret as a mighty spiritual warrior and king.

PCM 199 That Time with the King

According to Hebrew Chapter 6, there is a peril, a danger of not progressing. Everything in the Kingdom of GOD grows, grows to maturity. Our Heavenly Father requires fruit as we remain in Christ Jesus, the Vine. One of the best ways is to spend time with Him, the KING, and His Word. Journey with me as we study to shore up our foundations on repentance from dead works, faith towards GOD, the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection from the dead, of eternal judgment, and more so that we may grow up in all things into Him, who is the Head.

PCM 240 Developing a Sermon

The scriptures are replete with examples of men and women of God delivering evangelistic and teaching messages. Jesus in Matthew 28 commands the believer to go into the entire world and preach the gospel while Paul recognizes in Romans 10 that people cannot be converted unless someone preaches the good news. This course will be an in-depth course on how to prepare a biblical message for preaching. While its focus will be pulpit ministry, all should be able to prepare a message, as all Christians should be instant in season and out.
