COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

BNT 120 Book of Acts

The Holy Spirit operating through you, confirming God's Word, is the focal point in this detailed study of the book of Acts. We firmly believe that God wants to develop "signs following" ministries as a result of this class. Come on a journey as we build the early church and follow Paul on his journeys to impact the world and us.

PCM 510 Destroying Your Strongholds and Overcoming Your Enemy

When understanding and learning how to effectively engage in spiritual warfare, you must know your enemy. Ignorance is no excuse when you combat your adversary. When we allow ignorance in an area that He has clearly given us instruction for, we become very vulnerable to satanic attack. You will gain understanding for effective war against the strongholds you battle. You will be taught to use your spiritual authority administratively, compassionately but never presumptuously. We will deal primarily with the crucified thought life which is the area where our enemy will invade and take control of our lives in order to prevent our walk and success with the Lord.

TDH 450 The Holy Spirit: Who He is and Why We Can't Live Without Him

Many people are unfamiliar with who the Holy Spirit is and what role He has in their lives. They may be confused about or even intimidated by Him. Even many seasoned Christians have an easier time relating to God or Jesus, while the Spirit and his ways are often a mystery. Like Jesus's disciples, we wonder why Jesus had to leave earth so that the Spirit could come. In one sense, the Holy Spirit is surrounded by mystery because He is Spirit. But He is also personal and knowable. In fact, spiritually, we literally can't live without Him and the life he brings.

BOT 201 Prophet Isaiah

Some call Isaiah the "Saint Paul of the Old Testament". The sixty-six chapters of Isaiah resemble the sixty-six books of the Bible. The first thirty-nine chapters point to the Old Testament and the last twenty-seven chapters point to the New Testament. The theme of this course is salvation, judgment of sin, and the messianic promise.
