COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

PCM 437 Mantles-Find Your Fit

Biblically, a mantle represents a believer's call, their gifting and God's ordained purpose for their lives. This class is designed to provide an in-depth look at the spiritual technology of mantles. We will explore the purpose and use of mantles through biblical examples. Students will be taught to identify the work of mantles through spiritual acuity, and receive the necessary tools for holistic maintenance.

BOT 316a Book of Revelation

Probably no other book has been studied and interpreted with as wide of an understanding as the book of Revelation. Because of language use, symbolism and historical questionability, many readers have not known how to understand this book. On the other extreme, many others have used it to predict Christ's return or set charts laying out a definitive understanding of the end times. These were later refuted. We will seek to gain an understanding of Revelation within its historical context and see where and how, if at all, it applies to the end times.

BOT 306 I & II Chronicles

The books of Chronicles are not a repetition of the books of Kings. God pursued a special purpose with the writings of the Chronicles. The books give a divine retrospect over Israel's history and the history of mankind. We will be taking a close look at the House of David (Kingdom of Judah). God's people were never meant to blend in. We are called to stand out from the crowd and become a beacon of hope. Nothing dims our light more than conformity. In the study of Chronicles, you will see that the Jewish people paid a high price for conformity.

BOT 208b Psalms Part III

Like David, Moses and others who contributed to the Book of Psalms, you can come to know God as the tenderhearted Father, a God who keeps His promises and who lovingly cares for His people. We'll read about those who follow Him, their faith and doubts, their victories and failures, and their hopes for the glorious future God has promised.
